SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This scholarship was established to assist Butler and Warren County seniors who intend to pursue post-secondary education to obtain a degree. This could include a four-year college degree or a two-year college associate degree program.

The \$2,500 scholarship stipend will be paid in two payments. The first stipend of \$1,250 will be paid at the beginning of the first semester and the second will be paid at the beginning of the second semester under the following condition:

The GPA of an enrolled student must be 2.0 or better. If the GPA falls below 2.0 after the first semester, the student may become eligible for the second \$1,250 disbursement when they have achieved a cumulative 2.0 GPA and they have proof of registration before the funds can be released.

-----Regulations-----

Each scholarship applicant will **submit by March 29th** of their high school graduating year:

1. A scholarship application form.
2. A school transcript of high school units; a GPA of 3.0 or above is a requirement for scholarship eligibility.
3. A resume including the following items:
 - a. Personal Information
 - b. Extracurricular activities listed by school year
 - c. Community activities
 - d. Work experience
 - e. Career objective
4. An essay including your reasons for pursuing a post-secondary education.
